

Human Resources New Technology Quarterly Summary: Q2 2022



Introduction

Each quarter, new technologies in the HR space are developed at record rates. To track the key players in the human capital management (HCM) technology sector and the innovation they bring, HRO Today produces quarterly reports that summarize the top advancements in the industry and the funding initiatives that support product innovation. This data reveals critical information about today's industry leaders, new technologies, and their applications.

The HCM systems covered in this summary are those that include recruitment, employee records, performance, learning and development, compensation management, and compliance tools. The quarterly report features new products hitting the market, funding announcements for companies providing HR technology solutions, and merger and acquisition (M&A) activity that has direct implications for HR technology.



Second Quarter 2022 Overview

A July 2022 article in the *New York Times* reports that for the first time in three years, start-up funding is dropping. Investments in U.S. tech start-ups plunged 23 percent over the prior three months, to \$62.3 billion, the steepest fall since 2019. The funding and development of HR technologies in the second quarter of 2022 continued at a high level, though there were fewer announcements in the quarter. In total, there were 174 major announcements (those with at least \$1 million in funding) in the quarter, down substantially from the 246 in the first quarter of 2022 but up from the 150 in the second quarter of 2021.

Private equity and venture capital firms continued to invest heavily in HR technology, totaling \$4.70 billion in the second quarter

Private equity and venture capital firms continued to invest heavily in HR technology, totaling \$4.70 billion in the second quarter, up from \$4.48 billion in the first quarter of 2022 and up from Q2 2021's \$3.10 billion. The average investment in the second quarter was \$54.1 million, up from \$34.5 million in the first quarter of 2022 and up from \$49.10 year-over-year.

Of the 174 technology announcements, 113 were from companies located in the United States, eight from Canada, 31 from EMEA, 7 from APAC, and two from Latin America. The number of APAC announcements were down 76% from the prior quarter. Additionally, there were 13 joint announcements by geography, four of which were in the U.S. and EMEA. In the United States, 36 announcements were from companies in or near Silicon Valley, while in the EMEA region, 9 were from London-based companies.

The most common type of announcement was once again funding-related, with 92 citations. There were also 32 product announcements and 50 merger and acquisition announcements. The number of M&A transactions was down 34% from the prior quarter when there were 76 announcements.

Most announcements were around funding for small or startup organizations, though there were 17 announcements of at least \$100 million, up from 12 in 1Q 2022. The largest announcement came to \$400 million from Velocity Global, a global talent solution provider located in Denver, Colorado.

The next two largest announcements came from begom and Remote, both for \$300 million. Begom is a compensation management software provider out of Switzerland. Remote is a global payroll and HR provider for distributed and remote workforces from San Francisco, California.

HCM/Core HR platforms, which includes recruiting outside of marketplace job boards was the largest single area of investment, with \$1.4 billion announced in the second quarter. Spending in this area for the




first half of year has been \$2.1 billion. There were 35 announcements related to HCM/Core for the second quarter and 61 for the first half of 2022. Total investment in Payroll was \$1.1 billion in the second quarter and \$1.8 billion for the year. There were 31 Payroll announcements in the first half of 2022.

PwC's 25th Annual Global CEO Survey report reveals that 79% of US CEOs are concerned about a shortage of key skills.² Investment in learning reflects that challenge, as \$942 million was invested in the second guarter, and \$1.35 billion invested for in the first half of 2022.

Continued low unemployment rates, such as 3.6% in the U.S.³ and 3.8% in the UK,⁴ support the investment in marketplace job boards. In the second quarter, \$427 million was invested, bring the first half total to over \$1 billion. Fears of a recession within the next 12 months could negatively impact investment in this area.
