Refundable tickets can be cancelled for full refund anytime. Non-refundable tickets can be cancelled for travel credit (valid 1 year) but not refunded. Refundable cost more but provide more flexibility.


Can I see prices in different currencies?

Yes, if booking internationally. Delta's website automatically detects your location and shows prices in local currency. You can also change currency during booking if desired.

What if I find a cheaper price after booking?

If you find a cheaper non-refundable ticket within 24 hours, you can potentially cancel and rebook at lower price (losing original ticket if non-refundable). For refundable tickets, cancel and rebook at lower price. Check Delta's specific policy or call  1-855-321-3345.

How long does it take to receive my boarding pass?

Digital boarding pass is usually available 24 hours before departure through delta.com or Fly Delta app . You can also check in at airport (arrive 2 hours before for domestic, 3 hours for international).

Can I book for someone else?











Yes, you can book flights for other people. You just need their information (names as on ID, date of birth, email). You provide payment information. They can check in using their booking confirmation number.

Is it cheaper to buy one-way or round-trip tickets?

Generally, round-trip is cheaper than two one-way tickets. However, for complex itineraries or last-minute changes, one-way tickets provide flexibility. Compare both options when booking.
